# **Hertsmere Liberal Democrats**

# **Financial Report November 2023**

Accounts for the year to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022 are attached. However, since our AGM is held near to the end of the following calendar year these might be seen as being somewhat out of date.

**Income:** £8,391. The vast bulk of our income derives from donations by members. In the year under review, we received £7,399. This was supplemented by £453 of membership rebates from central and regional Liberal Democrats sources. Other fundraising events produced income of £539 (profit £405).

**Expenses: £4,291**. There were no major local or national elections during the year. The expenditure of £3,752 listed under this heading comprises of regular newsletters and other political literature largely in preparation for campaign in the following year. Fund raising costs were £134. Office costs etc amounted to £382.

Surplus for the Year: £4,100.

**Balance Sheet:** We started the year with total funds of £7,794. Having achieved a surplus of £4,100 we therefore ended the Year with reserves of £11,894.

#### **Update**

Accounts for the Year to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2023 cannot, of course yet be produced but donations for the 10 months to 31<sup>st</sup> October total £13,825. The principal reason for the increase over last year is that our greatly increased number of Councillors have been paying a regular tithe into Party funds. Membership Rebates amount to £1,450. Agents Expenditure were £5,961 whilst circulars, newsletters and other general campaigning literature plus some overheads amount to £7,771. This results in a surplus of income over expenditure of £1,542 for the period thereby boosting our reserves to £13,436.

#### **Future**

There are no local elections due in 2024 but a General Election is highly likely to be called. We must ensure that we are adequately funded to fight that campaign.
